TO THE GOVERNMENT OF ST. KITTS-NEVIS:

*prepared by Alfred de Grazia*

We, the undersigned, all being persons of full age, and at least two-thirds of our number being citizens of St. Kitts-Nevis, West Indies, desiring to form a corporation under the Laws of St. Kitts-Nevis, do hereby apply to the Government of St. Kitts-Nevis for a charter to be granted pursuant to the provisions of law, and do make, sign, and acknowledge the following statement:

First: The name of the proposed corporation is Alexander Hamilton College of St. Kitts-Nevis.

Second: The purposes for which such corporation is to be formed are:

- a. To establish, conduce, operate, and maintain without profit an independent private college together with associated centers of research, teaching, and conferences, for the benefit of the people of St. Kitts and Nevis and to the enlightenment and learning of the world;
- b. To purchase, receive, acquire, hold, use, own, sell, mortgage, pledge, lease, convey, and otherwise acquire or dispose of property of every kind and nature, real and personal or mixed for any one or more of the purposes of the corporation and to maintain any and all buildings, grounds and equipment owned or used in connection with the operation of the corporation;
- c. To obtain funds or gifts needed for any one or more of the purposes of the corporation by voluntary subscription or otherwise in conformity with the laws of St. Kitts-Nevis;
- d. To contract with others and to employ agents, employees and teachers and to make and perform contracts, leases, licenses and agreements for any lawful purpose for or incidental to the performance of its purposes or any of them;
- e. To borrow money and to mortgage, pledge and otherwise transfer or hypothecate any or all of its property, real, personal or mixed as security therefor;
- f. To make all by-laws and rules necessary and proper for the purposes of the college and not inconsistent with law; to do and perform all acts and things necessary, convenient and proper or desirable for the accomplishment of the purposes, or any thereof, or the attainment of the objects, or any thereof, hereinbefore set forth, in such case, however, only insofar as may be lawful under the laws of St. Kitts-Nevis.

Third: The corporation is to be a non-stock corporation. It is organized and shall be operated exclusively for educational purposes and not for pecuniary profit. No part of the earnings of the corporation shall enure to the benefit of any individual. No member, officer, trustee or employee shall receive or be lawfully entitled to receive any pecuniary profit from the operations of the corporation, except reasonable compensation ~~for services actually rendered in effecting one or more of its~~ purposes. In the event of dissolution, liquidation or winding up of the corporation, no member, officer, trustee or employee shall be entitled to receive distribution of any of the corporation assets, and the same shall be disposed of by the trustees pursuant to law for such non-profit purpose or purposes as they shall in their absolute discretion select or as a court of competent jurisdiction may direct.

Fourth: The institution to be maintained by the proposed corporation is to be located at Nevis, State of St. Kitts-Nevis, West Indies.

Fifth: The number of trustees is to be fifteen; the Board of trustees shall have power, by vote of two-thirds of the members of said board, to change the number of trustees to be not more than 25 nor less than 5.

Sixth: The names and post-office addresses of the first trustees are as follows:
